-Music Cue Sheet: This is mandatory if there is any music in the film.

-Copy of Copyright Registration

-Actor Releases: Total # of Necessary Releases (____)

-Music Contracts: Total # of Necessary Contracts (____)

-Miscellaneous Contracts: (if applicable) Total#: (____)

-Print Access: (if film print available) Initial here to grant distributor access to the print and/or authorization to strike a print.
